

## Bachelor of Arts in Education (BAE) Teacher Certification Upper Division Progression Requirements

For programs leading to teacher certification, students must meet the following criteria to progress into the upper division (300/400 level) courses. Upper division courses are listed in terms 5-8 on the major map. Please refer to the program major map for more details.

The information on this document is meant to be a general guide to outline requirements which must be completed prior to enrolling in term 5 courses. It is ideal that all courses listed on the major map in terms 1-4 are completed prior to starting term 5; however, students can begin term 5 with up to three courses outstanding. Students are required to meet with their MLFC advisor to determine if they have met progression requirements.

- 1. ASU (if applicable) and Transfer GPA of 2.25 or higher
- 2. Completion of 60 Credit Hours (courses may be in-progress but must be completed prior to starting term 5)
- 3. An Arizona Department of Public Safety Identity Verified Print (IVP) fingerprint clearance card
- 4. A grade of "C" or higher in the following general studies course requirements:
  - English Composition: ENG 101/102 or 107/108 or ENG 105
  - Mathematics: MAT 142/117 or higher (some secondary education specializations require higher)
  - Two Lab Sciences: (SQ and SQ/SG)
  - Required Lower Division Education Courses as outlined on major map
- 5. For Pre-K-8 majors, students are allowed 3 lower division courses outstanding (being mindful of pre-requisites).
- 6. For secondary education majors, additional content courses are required with a grade of a C or better based on the chart below.

SED – Biology	Content area: BIO 181 and BIO 182 CHM 113
SED – English	Content area: ENG 200 and two (2) more from required list on DARS
SED – History	Content area: Three (3) history courses from required list on DARS
SED – Mathematics	Content area: MAT 270; 271; and MAT 272 or MAT 207/MTE210
